EVENT HIGHLIGHTS



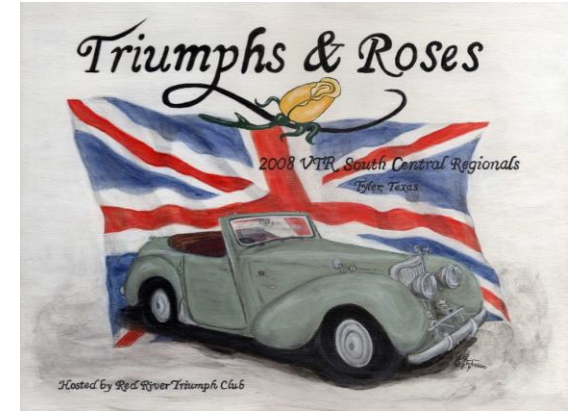
Our **dinner drive** will take the group to Henderson, Texas, and will leave early to provide time for a stroll down Main Street and

allow time for shopping before dinner. The 13 city blocks of the district contain 44 properties that are on the National Register. Today downtown Henderson offers a unique variety of shopping experiences housed in restored structures. Downtown includes, specialty shops, gifts, antiques, upscale clothing boutiques and restaurants. The Henderson National Register Historic District has maintained its integrity through the tragic fire of 1860, the Civil War, Reconstruction era, and the oil boom of the 1930's. In 1988, Henderson was designated a Texas Main Street Project City.



After Concours, we'll head out to see **Jerry Ball's** Private Car Museum. Jerry has cars of all shapes and sizes, mostly 50's and 60's models and they all run. Some of his cars are total restorations and some are all out hot rods. Along with the cars, there are display cases brimming with collectibles and memorabilia old and new.

The **Awards Banquet** will be a Western-style buffet and includes BBQ brisket, sausage and chicken with potato salad, coleslaw, bean, corn, cornbread, rolls and apple, peach, cherry or berry cobbler. Dinner includes tea/water/soda/coffee and we will have a cash bar set up.

The Tyler Municipal Rose Garden is a 14-acre park, making it the nation's largest rose garden. The garden is full of breath-taking beauty, especially in

the spring and again in mid-October when the Rose Garden is in full bloom. There are over 38,000 rose bushes of at least 500 different varieties, from tall grafted rose trees to miniature roses no larger than a dime.



The Cotton Belt Depot was built in 1905 and began serving passengers on the Cotton Belt Line in 1907. Visitors are encouraged to take a look around

and step back in time, remembering the thousands of travelers who passed through this historic structure in the early and mid-1900's. In addition to touring this historic building, visitors can also enjoy The Bragg Model Train Collection on permanent display at the depot. FREE admission!
